



Océ Arizona 360 GT/XT ONYX X10 Printer Drivers Released

The ONYX Profile and Printer Download Client (PDC) is normally used to download and create printer installation files for all Océ printers. The next update to the PDC from ONYX is planned to coincide with the release of X10.1 and that is currently scheduled for the end of June 2011. The final Océ Arizona 360 GT/XT drivers will not be available via the PDC until the release of X10.1. ONYX has provided DGS with released printer installation files for ONYX ProductionHouse Version X10 for the Océ Arizona 360 GT/XT printers. These are available on our web site on a temporarily basis and will be removed when X10.1 is released.

Hint: if you don't see ONYX Support in the left navigation pane, select Company and it will then show the link. Select Software and you will see the printer installation files and a patch file.

IMPORTANT:

- Ensure that you also install the patch mentioned in Océ Arizona 360 Service Information Bulletin 1160 "Patch Needed to Improve Saturation in HD Mode Prints".
- Discard the placeholder media models that are included with these printer installation files. They are called: CMYK-VarDot/NOPROFILE and CMYKW-VarDot/NOPROFILE
