



ONYX Updates Printer Installation Files for Version 7.2

Updated Océ Arizona 200/250/350GT printer installation files for ONYX Version 7.2 are available for download. We recommend that all Arizona printer customers update their 7.x version of ProductionHouse to the current version of 7.2 (7.2.0.59), and then update the driver(s) for their Océ Arizona 200, 250, and 350 GT printers. Use the versions currently posted (October 30th 2008) on the ONYX website.

The ONYX 7.2 update and the Arizona 200/250/350 GT printer installation files for 7.2 are posted on the ONYX site: www.onyxgfx.net

There is no driver available for the Océ Arizona 350 for 7.1 or earlier versions of ProductionHouse. These new printer installation files should be used with the current version of Arizona Printer Software.

NOTE: If the 200/250 GT printer installation file is used with printer software prior to version 2.7 the print job will fail when attempting to print from ONYX to the printer.

The Océ Arizona 350GT uses the same dll and key bit as the Océ Arizona 200/250GT. Make sure both printer installation file versions are current if you are printing to two different Arizona printer models from the same ONYX ProductionHouse computer.

To summarize the key points in this bulletin:

- Updated Océ Arizona 200/250/350 GT printer installation files are available for download from the ONYX website.
- These printer installation files can only be used with ONYX version 7.2 and the printer should be using the current version of printer software. Using obsolete printer software could cause problems.
- There is no Océ Arizona 350 GT driver for ONYX versions prior to 7.2
